1. Each tournament entry fee will be \$25.00; \$5.00 will be deducted and held to be added for the Series Finals.
2. Each tournament will have \$500.00 GUARANTEED added money, with an estimated \$4000.00 added to the total series.
3. All withheld monies will be paid out at the Series finals.
4. ALL match results will be recorded and used to assist in future handicapping.
5. Must have participated in 3 series events (only 9-ball event qualifies) in order to participate in the finals.
6. The series finals will have a BONUS 9 Ball team competition, made up of 3 person teams. Each teams skill level must follow the guidelines below:
 - a. No more than 1 A or 2 B's allowed on any one team
 - b. Team event will be held Friday February 3rd at 7:30pm (the finals may need to be held during the Series Finals the following day due to time restraints).

-----MUST PARTICIPATE IN ATLEAST 2 SERIES 9-BALL EVENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN TEAM EVENT-----

 - c. Team match will consist of 9 games each player playing the opposing player once
 - d. Each legally pocketed ball 1 through 8 will be 1 point, legally pocketing the 9 ball will be worth 4 points
 - e. No points awarded for pocketed balls on any foul. No spotting of balls except the 9 ball.
 - f. Match is over once a team has been mathematically eliminated from scoring enough points to win.
 - g. All ties will be decided by a playoff any one player from both teams. This play off will be a best of 3, alternate break. Home team is to flip the coin and the visiting team will call the flip. It is the winner of the flips decision to break or rack first.
 - h. Entry fee is \$90.00 per team
 - i. There will be a team auction for the event
7. For further details, please call or see either of the Series Directors (Brian Gregg or Jessie Rogers).
8. Headphones are ALLOWED, however Cell phones are NOT. If your cell phone rings or you are on your cell phone during your match, you will forfeit that game. If you are caught twice, you forfeit the match.
9. There will be one time out per match for a period of 5 minutes (some exceptions may apply).
10. ALL matches must take place on the DIAMOND tables. Any match played on the Valley tables will not count.
11. Tournament directors have the right to eject any player at any time for any reason.
